# Bay Types

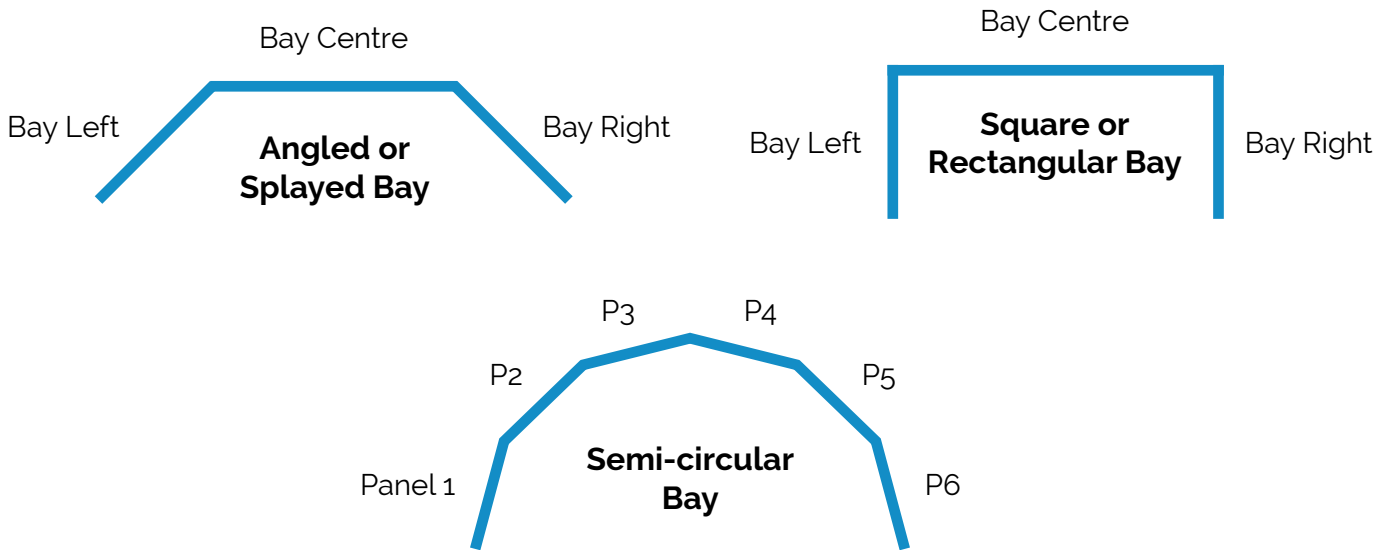
Each section of the bay can be considered as an individual unit. In general terms there are 3 types of Bay window which can be split into 2 groups:

## Group 1 - 3 Section Bays

1. Angled Bays
2. Square / Box Bays 90o returns
3. Bay Sections Left, Centre & Right

## Group 2 - Curved or Multi Section Bays

1. Generally, 4,5,6 or 7 sections
2. These can be labelled Panel 1, Panel 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 etc



You can select a unit type to best match the primary window design for both appearance and access requirements. The units can then be built with an angled frame section so when coupled together form the shape of the bay, see the Measuring and Bay template Guides on our website:

**6 Panel Curved Bay**

**5 Panel Curved Bay**

2 Hinged Units each end of 3 x Lift-Out Units

Suite of Hinged Units - Closed



**5 Panel Curved Bay**

Suite of Hinged Units - Open
