Double Glazing vs. Secondary Glazing (Noise Reduction)

Use the comparison table below to help you decide what's right for you...

	Double Glazing	Clearview Secondary Glazing
Appearance	Completely changes the appearance. Your existing windows are removed and replaced by modern plastic DG frames. Lose character, charm and any period features (including any stained glass). May look 'odd' set against neighbouring properties with a traditional period look.	Keeps your existing windows and period features safe. Unobtrusive glazing maintains the character appearance of your window. Suitable for listed buildings and conservation areas. In keeping with the neighbourhood.
Noise Reduction (Performance)	Does little to reduce noise (often no more effective than single glazing)	With right specification and acoustic glass, a 50dB reduction is possible (that is 5 times the performance of double or triple glazing) The equivalent of HALVING the noise entering your room or home.
Price	Replacement with uPVC window often MORE expensive than the repair and secondary glazing option.	Typically more cost effective and better long term value alternative to double glazing. DIY or specialist fit options.
How long does it last?	May last 20-30 years before the need to replace again.	Can last longer than 30 years
Supply & Fitting	Should only be fitted by a regis- tered professional	Supply Only (DIY fitting) or Supply & Fit by specialist secondary glazing fitters. Can be fitted to double glazed windows
Redecoration	Redecoration required after fitting	NO redecoration needed



Double Glazing vs. Secondary Glazing (Noise Reduction)

Use the comparison table below to help you decide what's right for you...

	Double Glazing	Clearview Secondary Glazing
Good for the Environment?	A heavy double glazed window unit uses THREE times the material of a secondary glazing unit. Your old windows usually end up in landfill. Work is messy and requires a clean up.	Uses three times LESS material than a double glazing equivalent. Contributes to carbon emission reduction. Simple and clean to install.

Condensation	Can reduce condensation if heating-ventilation balance is right	Eliminates condensation in almost all cases
Impact on Property Value	Irrevocably effects the historic value and fabric of the building	Completely reversible installation
